

Knolls Village Townhouse Association Swimming Pool Rules

POOL ATTENDANTS HAVE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY FOR OUR FACILITY AND ALL FACILITY RESOURCES

To use the pool, homeowners/residents must have a signed Pool Agreement on file with the Association, as well as a current Pool Registration Key Card for entry.

Residents whose monthly HOA fees/dues are not current will be denied use of pool facilities.

- The pool season opens on Memorial Day weekend and closes on Labor Day. It is open daily, weather permitting. Pool hours are 9:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m. and open to all eligible, registered KVTA pool users. As daylight diminishes in late summer, pool hours may be shortened.
- The pool is reserved daily for **adults only** between 9:00-10:00 a.m. and 5:30-6:00 p.m.
- When the weather forecast is for cool weather the pool staff determines whether to open the pool.
- Registration forms are available on www.knollsvillage.com and the bulletin board.
- Please do not enter the pool area when the pool is closed. Doing so could result in loss of pool privileges for the entire household.

If you are renting your townhouse, you must provide a *Tenant Release Form* signed by the homeowner to use the pool facilities. Submit the Tenant Release form at registration. The form is available on the bulletin board and the KVTA website – www.knollsvillage.com.

POOL REGULATIONS

**Use of the pool and facilities is strictly at your own risk. There is no lifeguard on duty.
Running, splashing, or nuisance activities are strictly prohibited.**

- Glass or breakable containers are not permitted in pool areas.
- Alcohol and tobacco products are prohibited in pool areas.
- Pets (leashed or otherwise) are not permitted in pool areas.
- Children who are household members between the ages of 13 to 15 will be allowed to sponsor 1 guest. Children who are household members ages 16 to 20 may sponsor 2 guests.
- Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied at all times by a parent or other authorized adult.
- Guests must be accompanied by a resident at all times.
- Guests of residents are limited to 5 unless previously approved.
- Pool privileges will be suspended in instances of vandalism.
- Wading pool use is reserved for children age 6 or under and must be accompanied by a parent or authorized person, age 18 or older.
- Children not yet toilet trained must wear a swim diaper.
- Shower facilities are available for both before and after pool use. Showers must be kept to a 5-minute maximum.
- Flotation devices may be limited and require approval from the pool attendant on duty.

We encourage everyone to help keep our pool areas safe and clean.

The pool gazebo area may be reserved for a two-hour period only for a maximum of 15 people. The gazebo area may **not** be reserved concurrently with the Clubhouse. See the pool attendant on-site for gazebo reservations.
