Message from the President

November 2013

As we moved toward year-end 2013, here are some "reminders" for everyone to consider:

With darkness now earlier, we all need to leave our outside lighting on, as matter of security. It also adds a sense of warmth to our community. We continue to recommend the installation of 'dusk- to-dawn fixtures' at both the front and the back of your home. It is a rather insignificant expense but gives the impression that someone may well be at home. The Association will be adding lighting throughout neighborhoods to provide for safety and security. Please do turn on front door lights over-night.

Blade Runners will be handling leaf collection a couple of times this month and homeowners may wish to also have gutters cleaned out before the winter snows come. It does help to protect your attic from ice building up on the edges of the roof. This is not a matter of the Association's responsibility, so it is up to each owner to clean and maintain their own gutters. Unhooking your hoses is also recommended.



Your Architectural Control Committee would remind everyone that real estate signs may only be placed at the back of a unit which is to be sold or rented. These signs are **not permitted** on the front of any unit. Anyone driving through our complex looking for residency will see signage placed in the driveways.

The Board has authorized Warren and his staff to replace broken or damaged globes on light fixtures in the rear walkways as needed and we have asked them to remove window well covers in the front of any home that are either cracked or broken. Replacements will not be provided, since the covenants state that these small egresses do not necessarily need to be covered. Where a resident chooses to do so, a flat clear cover must to be used in the future since the bubble-type covers are no longer permitted.

Victor and Alex will be removing more of our old and tired shrubbery along with their winter pruning projects. This would be a good time for us all to clear the front steps and porches of 'things of little value' to keep our property looking neat and tidy. As always, we shall remove snow from sidewalks, whenever we get more that several inches of snow, including your front steps – even for homeowners who seldom use the front door. You should check the front of your home periodically since, while we do our best to prevent door to door solicitors hanging coupons on door handles, we do not have a formal policing system in place.

My hope is that as we settle in for the winter, we can still find some time to be a good neighbor and keep an eye out for one another. In the meantime, enjoy this beautiful season Dick

Moist Crock Pot Pork Chops

6 Pork Chops

1 can condensed cream of celery soup

Place chops in crockpot. Cover with sliced onions, condensed soup and 1/4 cup water. Add pepper to taste. Cover and cook all day (7 to 8 hours) on LOW or 1/2 day (3 to 4 hours) on HIGH in crockpot. You can also add a package of dry boxed stuffing (with herb packet) on top of chops first then the onions and soup and water.

Unbelievably moist, tender chops.
