Perhaps someone won a lottery! We all need a little good news so please call me if you did. It would be good to look into someone's eyes appearing less than discouraged these days.

Well, your KVTA board met this past week and everything seems to be going really well. Warren, his staff, and others have been keeping up with plowing and shoveling driveways and sidewalks, ah, there is good news. Winter pruning will be on hold until a break in the snow and we get some warmth back in the daytime weather. When we resume removing junipers and other overgrown shrubs, we will not be putting new plants back as it is not the right time to be re-planting. Fear not, in the spring, we will get back with restoring those beds. For anyone walking small pets, do be careful of their time outside, as little feet suffer some damage with these really low temperatures.

Contact was made with the City of Centennial concerning plowing sidewalks along University Blvd. Their policy is to clear those walks if the area gets 4" of snow or more and they had assumed their personnel were doing so. Warren informed them that this has not been the case, so they will supervise that activity more carefully going forward. With more snow falls, we shall still continue to request Blade Runners make one pass with their equipment when they are on site for us.

The Board has come to the conclusion that we MUST enforce our community bylaws which provide for overflow parking, needing indeed to be "temporary". We shall write a single warning letter whenever we believe a vehicle is in violation, providing the owner 15 days to remove it from the association's property. At the end of the two week period the vehicle will be towed at the owner's expense. Garages being used for storage, rather than parking vehicles is an unacceptable excuse with storage facilities available at many convenient locations around this and surrounding communities.

A landscape committee is being formed which will meet and determine plans for restoration of the flower bed at the entrance to our clubhouse and the Geddes Avenue entrance to our community. Their work will begin in spring and we are anxious to see their ideas and plans they bring with water conservation a priority.

Before we know it .. Spring .. then Summer! So we can complain about the heat .. Dick

GARAGE BREAK-IN

At least one garage was broken into at the Knolls Village during the month of January. It was noted by the Sheriff's Deputy that the garage side door was an easy access point for the break in and it may have been prevented if the strike plate for the lock had been stronger. You can make your home and garage more secure by installing dead bolt locks and making sure that strike plates for locks are fastened not only to the door jamb, but with long screws through the door jamb into the framing of the wall.
