# Message from the President

Ours is a "covenant controlled community" and as such, your Board and our ACC, wish to remind everyone that window well covers, while not mandatory, provide a measure of safety to always curious children as well as small animals. We, therefore, recommend clear, flat, strong plastic covers to provide protection and also to keep debris from accumulating in these spaces. The issue of insurance rests with you, the homeowner. Bubble type covers are unacceptable and they, as well as cracked or faded covers will be removed by our staff if looking shabby. Preserving our community with a 'consistent-look' and 'cared-for' appearance protects your property value and makes Knolls Village a terrific place to own or rent. It is up to us all to consider the image we portray to those who live or visit here and to anyone who might consider moving here. Warren and staff are not responsible for how your home appears.

A sore subject with the Board is the condition of some walk-ways to patios between garages. Storing materials and other debris, the condition of the concrete, deteriorating gates are visually unattractive. We suggest that you stand at the driveway entrance to the back of your home and consider the image. Each year at this time, the association has a concrete contractor replacing sidewalks and curbs. It would be easy enough, with them on site, to add a few extra projects for their crews and be less expensive for anyone wishing to avail themselves of these services.
