If you have not been to the clubhouse recently, I suggest you drop by and see what a small group of volunteers have done in landscaping there. We now have a showcase, of which even Mother Nature would be proud, hail storm aside. Ladies ... the Board appreciates both your talents and your efforts.

We again have a full complement of ACC walkers with the addition of 5 new volunteers, several of whom are new to our community. KVTA is a 'Covenant Controlled Community' and these are the folks who act as the "eyes" for the Board to help maintain the appearance and standards expected throughout the neighborhood, all of which maintains the property values of your homes.

Volunteering by residents helps to maintain the extremely low dues compared to other communities of our size and our age here in Colorado and is also a great way for folks to get to know one another better and creates a means of building 'community' within Knolls Village. Neighborliness is a priority of this association and what will further stand us apart as a wonderful place to call home.

Our pool staff folks are compensated to maintain the facility which looks better than ever, however, they are not there to act as a child sitting service. A responsible parent must be at the pool whenever their children are present and we expect that parent to keep their youngsters obeying the pool rules and, therefore, safe. Where necessary, the staff has the right to suspend 'family' pool privileges.


SUNDAY JULY 13TH POOLSIDE

RHUBARB BERRY SLAB PIE

- 2 pkgs refrigerated pie crust
- 4 cups Rhubarb (Chopped)
- 2 quarts Fresh Strawberries
- 2 pints Fresh Blackberries
- 1 cup Light Brown Sugar
- 1 cup Sugar

- 1/3 cup Cornstarch
- 2 cups Semi-Sweet Chocolate Chips
- 1 Egg (For Egg Wash)
- 2 tablespoons Sugar In The Raw
- Powder Sugar (For Garnish)
- Whipped Cream (For Garnish)
- Line the bottom of your oven with a sheet of foil. Preheat oven to 400°F. Grease a 18" X 13" inch sheet pan.
- Roll out doughs to (2) 24"x19" rectangles. Line the pan with 1 piece of dough.
- In a large bowl combine Rhubarb, Berries, Sugars and Cornstarch. Spread the Chocolate Chips on the bottom of the pan (on top of the dough). Add the Berries and top with the remaining dough.
- In a small bowl, whisk together the Egg and 1 tablespoon of water. Brush on top of the dough. Sprinkle with Sugar in the Raw.
- Bake for 35-40 minutes until top is golden. Serve with Powdered Sugar and Whipped Cream.
- **Helpful Tips:** This pie is made in a sheet pan; Spread chocolate chip on dough in the bottom of the pan and add the berries on top second; Spreading the chocolate at the bottom of the pie prevents the juice on the top from making a soggy crust on the bottom; Finish the top of the pie with egg wash and sugar on top of the pie to make the crust even crunchier.
