Message from the President

July 2014

A 'Covenant Controlled Community' has guidelines and regulations which benefit all our residents and protects the integrity of this neighborhood, thereby maintaining property 'value' for all homeowners.

Things To Consider:

- We are a neighborhood, just as any other in the City of Centennial, different only in that
 we live a little closer to one another, so the Association asks for consideration as to
 noise after 10PM.
- Dog barking, for periods of twenty minutes or longer, is against a Centennial City ordinance and complaints may result in your pet being removed from your home or yard.
- 3. The City has a 'legally regulated curfew', with which your KVTA agrees, for anyone under 18 to be off the streets by 11PM from Sunday through Thursday and 12AM on Friday and Saturday.
- 4. The parking or standing of boats, trailers, or motor homes for periods longer than 48 hours may result in fines of several hundred dollars per day or the police can arrange for a towing service.

All these considerations are a matter for the Arapahoe County Sherriff Department who may be contacted directly whenever a resident has a complaint AND your name and address is not required! The non-emergency telephone number for the Sheriff's Department is 303-795-4711.

Other Considerations:

- Keeping front and rear lights on overnight is a deterrent to crime and loitering, so we
 encourage either turning lights on at dusk and off at dawn or installing lighting which will
 handle it for you.
- Waste Management wishes to remind everyone that garbage is 'safest' when bagged and
 tied so as to keep crows and squirrels out, and your private information from being blown
 about. Their drivers are not required to pick up scattered or loose trash so please attend to
 your trash appropriately.
- Our neighborhood of 40 plus acres has never looked better!
- Warren, Victor, Alex, and Casey, together with Blade Runners and Rushton Tree Service, are doing such a wonderful job for which your Board is most grateful. We would, however, ask certain dog owners to help keep the grounds looking this good by trying to remember a bag when walking your pet(s). It only takes a few seconds to handle and does encourage those who pick up to continue.
- We are completely replacing "our street", Geddes Place, west of Knolls Way. I say our street, because many in the community are unaware that the City of Centennial assumes no responsibility for either this section of Geddes, or all of Columbine Way. We sincerely apologize to all residents who will be inconvenienced during this activity but once completed; we will then turn our attention to restoring all remaining driveways, following which all our road and driveway surfaces should be able to handle the double-axle vehicles going forward.
