Junior Mint Chocolate Chip Cookie Cups

- 16 ounces chocolate chip cookie dough (I used half of a 32 ounce tube of Pillsbury cookie dough)



30 Junior mints (from a 4 ounce box)

Instructions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350°F. Spray mini muffin pans with cooking spray (I like the kind with flour for these).
- Drop 1 heaping tablespoon of cookie dough in each muffin cavity. 2.
- Bake for 8-10 minutes until the cookies are a light golden brown. 3.
- 4. Press a junior mint on top of the cookies right after they come out of the oven. Let cool completely before removing from pans.
