Message from the President

October 2014

Are you wondering what has been going on in the KVTA neighborhood so far this year? Well, where to start? Completely replaced Geddes Place from S. Knolls Way to S. Knolls Way including curbs and temporary parking sections, preparing a budget for 2015 to be presented to the Annual Homeowner's Meeting on October 14th, continuing with replacement of a very antiquated sprinkler system, a new roof on the clubhouse, repainting of the fencing around the pool and clubhouse, re-landscaping the front entrance to our clubhouse, as well as the front of several rows of homes where sprinkler updating continues, re-grading the ends (sides) of our ranch units to provide better drainage, continuing with the removal of more overgrown and outdated shrubs, all of which have been handled by either Warren and his staff, or outside contractors, or volunteer residents.
