### Message from the President

December 2014

What an incredible year this has been, due in large part to a 'wonderful' Board of Directors, a 'rejuvenated' Architectural Control Committee, Warren and his staff, as well as any number of independent contract companies who perform and respond well to all the many service issues which keep the neighborhood and our community in such fabulous condition.

On behalf of all our residents, I wish to say - "THANK YOU" - to all who serve the KVTA Association.

Please take notice of some new trees planted in Booth Woods, thanks to a donation from a homeowner ... the stone re-landscaping in front of an entire row of townhomes on S. Knolls Way ... an end of season leaf and pine needle pick up, preparing the lawns for winter snowfall, which will be here soon enough ... clubhouse Christmas decorations in place ... all contributing to the grounds looking the best I can ever remember ... and perhaps an additional reason for the continuing increases in our property valuations.

Many of the new homeowners who have come to live in the KVTA neighborhood during this past year have done so as a matter of down-sizing and have paid cash for their homes. While some are retired, others have young families with small children, so it is also important for everyone to watch out for the little folk in driveways. As a reminder speed limits in garage areas are 10 miles per hour or less, and let's all be extra careful to watch for children darting out between vehicles parked on our streets as well.

With winter snowfalls, our driveways will be plowed first, usually before anyone needs to get going to work, KVTA neighborhood streets second, and then sidewalks when accumulations are in excess of 3 inches. CDOT is responsible for University Boulevard, as a main thorough-fare, while the City of Centennial is responsible for all sidewalks along University and will be plowing the walkways with their own special equipment likely within a day following a storm. We will have Blade Runners assist with sidewalks on University, only if the City is un-responsive. Blade Runners will then only be on our property for snow if our staff find themselves unable to keep up in situations of excessive snow accumulations. We would ask all drivers to be extra cautious, during and following snow days, as many residents who do not drive may be using streets to walk in order to get to school, to shopping, or may be visiting within the community.
