Message from the President



Warren and the Board, have asked me to bring to the attention of all homeowners the issue of stress on the front concrete block at the front entrance to your townhome. Soil compaction over the years, together now with rabbits making their homes beneath these areas, is causing the weight of these affected concrete slabs to begin pulling away from the front door casing, including some brick and mortar. This block (slab) is your responsibility, as homeowner, and any damage to it and the structure of your home will be expensive to replace. We have been filling with dirt and bark (or stone) in the bed areas but these fixes are temporary. The best way to mediate this hollowing-out is to mud -jack beneath the slab to take the pressure off the weight of the block. The sheer size of some slabs is more significant than others, however, some blocks ought to be evaluated for structural soundness, and soon.

I have been receiving texts, emails, and messages concerning vehicles parked in driveways, which are posted fire lanes (\$100 fine), after hours noise issues (\$300 fine), and dogs off leash (\$100 fine per dog). While these are all covenant restrictions here at KVTA, 'complaints' need to be addressed to the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Department at 303-795-4711. This is what you would be expected to do, if you lived in any other suburb within the City of Centennial. The Sheriff can fine for such offenses. While we are looking into to instituting a fine system regarding our covenants, it will be quite a procedure and will take some time to arrange.

On a brighter note, no one can deny that Mother Nature, with a lot of help from Warren and the grounds maintenance people, have us looking fabulous. Now it is up to us all to keep it looking that way. Please do your part, perhaps pick up a little litter and such ... our staff is busy enough with the more major property concerns, pruning dead branches, removing shrubs and preparing our pool for opening.

Am looking forward to a great turnout for our neighborhood coffee at the clubhouse on Saturday, May 16 from 9 to 11 am ... anxious to meet any new residents, owner or tenant who stop by for a donut and to check out all that is going here in our community.

The pool opens Friday, May 22, weather permitting. There will not be a morning adult swim on opening day.

All pool users must re-register to use the facilities. If you are a previous pool patron, bring your key and current member card to re-register. If you are a tenant, bring a completed *Tenant Release* form (signed by your landlord) which can be downloaded via the Pool and Tennis link on the home page at www.knollsvillage.com. Copies are also available on the bulletin board or you can email me and I will send you one. *Any resident whose dues payments are not current will be denied use of the facilities.*

Once you have been issued a key there will be a \$3.00 charge for a replacement key. If you need an additional key/member card the fee will be \$5.00. Use of and access to the facilities will not be permitted without possession of the member card and key. Please bring them with you each time you visit the pool facilities.

The 2015 pool rules will be provided to you at registration. Please review carefully as they will be strictly enforced. **All guests must be accompanied by a pre-registered resident**.

The gazebo may be reserved for birthday parties or special occasions, but we limit the time spent and number attending. **Prior approval** must be obtained from the pool manager or pool attendant.

Both pools open daily at 9:30 am for adult swim and children under 5 accompanied by an adult. Open swim begins at 10:30. Children over the age of 5 will not be permitted into the facility prior to 10:30 am. There is also an afternoon adult swim time from 4:30 to 5:00 pm. Please check in and leave your member card and key with the pool attendant upon arrival. The showers and bathrooms close at 7:45 pm and pools close at 8:00 pm.

I am confident a fun, safe and enjoyable time will be had by all this summer. Mindfulness of your fellow swimmers and all staff members is the key. I look forward to seeing everyone and welcoming our new residents to this great community.
