A few things for your consideration this month. Trees in Yards: Please be aware that you are responsible for the upkeep of trees in your yard.

> Please be thoughtful of your neighbors if your tree drops leaves or other materials in your neighbor's yard. You may want to offer to clean up the neighbor's yard or remove part or all of a tree if it is causing problems for your neighbors that you are unable to address it by cleaning up after your tree.

Also, keep in mind, that trees can cause problems with gas, sewer, and water lines in your yard or your neighbor's yard, and as the owner of the tree you are liable for those damages.

If you have a dead tree in your back yard, you must remove it for both safety and aesthetic reasons. ACC will be sending Out of Compliance letters when dead trees are noted.

As always, we appreciate the way we all work together to keep our community beautiful!
