complex cost. Each time we cycle the sprinklers, it costs between \$500 and \$700. We've looked at non-potable wells, but water rights are tightly managed by Denver Water. A leaky plumbing fixture can easily generate an additional \$100 plus per month.

Upcoming projects include upgrading the cul-de-sac areas with cobble stones, replacing more sprinkler zones, replacing sunken concrete sidewalk pads and more aggressive trimming/shearing in the complex. Wishing everyone a great summer.

2017 Mid-Year Financial Update

Summer is in full swing and improvements at Knolls Village continue. As your KVTA Treasurer, I closely monitor the financials and present an annual budget for approval each October. Homeowners have asked me to share an update, especially given the dues increase in January.

The Board focuses on projects needing repair/replacement. This includes two roads - Columbine Way and Geddes Pl. (West of Knolls Way), 34 driveways for the 374 townhomes, miles of sidewalks, a sprinkler system covering our 43 acres, the swimming pool and the clubhouse. In the past 10 years the following has been replaced: both roads; 30% of the sprinkler system; approximately half the driveways; numerous sections of sidewalks and most recently significant work at the swimming pool. Each of the roads cost about \$90,000 and driveway replacement averages around \$70,000 (with concrete) per alley.

The work at the pool is nearing completion. We replaced the pool skimmers and nearly all of the concrete deck. Every existing concrete pad was cracked and showed signs of settling/movement. We discovered numerous gaps underneath the old pads during removal. Our contractor removed and replaced significant amounts of soil with road base material to prevent the new concrete from shifting. Pressure testing of the pool plumbing was conducted along with updating the electrical bonding of the new concrete pad. While we have spent approximately \$66,000 for these improvements it is far less than the total replacement of the entire pool.

The Association also focuses on the day-to-day operating costs required to maintain our property that include water, lawn care, staff payroll, garbage service, etc. Our biggest variable continues to be our water

A few things for your consideration this month.

Back Gates: Many of you have replaced your gates over the years and painted or stained them so they are not only functional but look great. Unfortunately, some of the original gates that are 35 years old are still in place and many of those are in bad shape from a functional and esthetic perspective. The ACC has discussed the issue with the board, and we have agreed it is time to tackle the issue across our property so we can upgrade the entire look of our community. This effort was initiated last year and will be completed this year.

If you have a gate that needs to be replaced, you will be receiving a letter from the ACC with your replacement options. Details on replacement requirements are in the Homeowners Guide and will also be included in the letter. Once you decide on a gate replacement, be sure to complete an ACC Request Form for approval before replacing your gate.

Unpainted Wooden Front Doors: KVTA strongly recommends that owners follow the direction provided in the KVTA paint schemes to paint their front doors in the designated color. Unpainted wooden front doors often require additional upkeep on the part of the owner since unpainted doors are NOT cared for in the KVTA painting process.

If your unpainted front door requires attention (and some still do!), you will be receiving a letter from the Architectural Control Committee that provides options for you to resolve the issue.

As always, we appreciate the way we all work together to keep our community beautiful!
