Our community is large with many obstacles when it comes to removing snow. We own snow blowers for aggressive storms that leave us with deep snow and contractually snow removal begins with an accumulation of two inches. Snowfall may not accumulate to two inches but our crew frequently works every path, driveway and sidewalk on off-hours as needed. Please be patient with them and remember that clearing the sidewalk access to your back gate is your responsibility to provide driveway access for the fire department in case of an emergency.

Painting the fence along University has taken more effort than anticipated and has required some extra finances. The fence appeared to be sturdy and protective, but upon close inspection it needed substantial repairs. Many of the rails, pickets and posts were rotted and required replacement. You can see the handiwork of our maintenance crew since the new wood has no stain. The project will be incomplete until the wood that was replaced dries before it will accept a stain treatment. The fence will be stained as soon as weather permits in the Spring.
