FROM DAVID KAISER PRESIDENT OF THE HOMEOWNERS' ASSOCIATION

With all the snow we've received this winter. it's hard to imagine that drought conditions are just around the corner. But that is our reality living in the high desert environment of the Front Range. As the climate warms and our local population increases the demand for water grows right along with it, however, the supply of water is not growing. This imbalance will only lead to higher and higher prices for each gallon of water we use.

Conservation is the key moving forward. During my time on the HOA Board, I have been pushing for more water efficiency in our landscape maintenance. I know we all enjoy green spaces, but they are very expensive to maintain in terms of irrigation, materials and labor. Recognizing this fact, the Colorado State Legislature is currently looking at an incentive program that will pay property owners to eliminate grass.

We need to be smarter about how much and where our maintained lawns should be to have the most benefit. As our relandscaping efforts continue, small strips of grass are being eliminated along the fronts and sides of buildings for replacement by water efficient plants, a variety of stone mulches, and selected space for annuals and perennials when requested by the resident.

The re-landscaping efforts are being done in conjunction with the replacement of our 40-year-old irrigation system. The new system will have water efficient pop-up heads, drip irrigation around new plants and smart technology that will detect leaks and allow for remote operation by our maintenance staff.

Finally, there are steps each of us can take to reduce our personal water consumption, including shorter shower times, larger laundry loads and repairing running toilets and dripping faucets. If we all do our small part, it will go a long way in reducing our monthly water bill.
