#### Centennial Center of Generations open now at the Streets of Southglenn -6972 S Vine St. #366

Centennial is home to an innovative new community space that serves older adults and teens. The Center of Generations, a partnership between the City of Centennial and the Denver Metro YMCA, opened June 7, 2023. The city had long wanted to open such a space for its residents but didn't have the staff capacity or knowledge. That is where the Denver YMCA stepped in.

The Denver YMCA has experience managing youth programs and older adult programs at various centers and sites around the front range so was anxious to lend its expertise to the new center. Working closely with city staff a site was identified in the Streets of Southglenn. The center opened with Older Adult hours between 10AM and 3PM and Teens welcomed between 4:00 PM and 8:00 PM.

Older adults meet new friends while participating in chair yoga, Silver Sneakers and Tai Chi classes. Programs such as book talk, classic board games, and visual journaling also provide opportunities for socialization. A small kitchen, allows the Center to host food and nutrition events, including some organized by Center members.

Teens can participate in ESports, movie nights, resume writing and nutrition classes. It is a goal of the center to have older adults and teens participate in joint activities. Ideas include teen interviewing veterans and writing their stories, technology sharing, Esports competitions and more.
