Notes from the Treasurer's Desk

April 15 is fast approaching, and the HOA taxes are done. Next up is collecting data for the audit and reviewing and finalizing the Reserve Study which will be for 2026. Expenses are going up for both operating expenses and capital improvements.

We are looking at various ways to keep costs under control. We have signed a new lower cost contract with a new landscaping company. The tennis courts have needed some serious repair so we have been collecting data since last fall for a solution, fine tuning the 2025 budget. We are keeping a safe amount of reserves but this results in funding for replacing both tennis courts as not financially feasible. The board is working with a couple of contractors for replacing the west tennis/pickleball court. We are pleased to find out we can probably keep our grandfathered status for our pickleball court but must keep the existing location. Once construction starts the courts will be unavailable for 6 weeks. We are also getting landscaping estimates from our new landscaping company for the current east court location. We hope to have some numbers by the April 1 homeowner's meeting.

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We are in the process of moving our web page to a new company. In the coming month you will see changes to the site including a better search capability and updates including the revised 2025 budget, current minutes of meetings, and as always the BackGate newsletter. There should be very little service interruption.

The cost of the painting contract went up this year and is now over the amount collected from dues but extra funds are available from previous painting funds. Painting will be starting soon.
