IF YOU Have Been Missed in Trash or Recycling Pick-Up and did everything correctly. please IMMEDIATELY (like Friday evening, certainly by Saturday) call the main, KVTA number 303-304-8976 or 303-796-0540. Warren will try to let Waste Management, KVTA's contractor, know. Perhaps they can do an individual pick-up or issue KVTA a refund. Remember, time is of the essence!

To Obtain Pool and/or Court Keys: Please fill out the form in the knollsvillage.com website, review rules, and obtain the physical signature of your owner/whoever you pay rent to (if renting), and send the completed form to the name and physical address on form or website. Note that this must be done in hard copy, no emails will be accepted. Forms can be deposited in the Black Box near the Clubhouse.

Sewer System Inspection and Maintenance

During the month of May, sewer main lines throughout the Knolls Village will be video inspected and cleaned as needed by DES Pipeline Maintenance. Inspection and cleaning will be done through manholes, mostly located in the lawn areas. The equipment used for inspection will need to be parked as close to manholes as possible. We will contact residents if equipment needs to be parked at the end of a driveway where it may block garage access. Please stay away and keep children and pets away from the work area, while the inspection and cleaning is in progress. Thank you for your understanding.

Architectural Control Committee Covenant Corner – A few things for your consideration this month.

Our Front Areas are owned by KVTA; however, many folks have taken it upon themselves to enhance and maintain their front areas. If you choose to do that as well, you will need to get approval before making any changes. To obtain approval, please fill out an ACC Application Form for Exterior Improvements/Changes and return as directed on the form. Application Forms are available online (www.knollsvillage.com) or at the Bulletin Board by the Clubhouse. Also note, the HOA is re-doing our front areas as funds and labor are available, during paint cycles.

Rabbit Holes Under Front Porches: Over the years, the dirt under many of our porches has settled, weakening porch support. Rabbit burrows under porches can create additional stress and cause your porch to crack, or in some cases collapse entirely, causing damage to your townhouse itself. If you have a rabbit hole under your porch, we urge you to be proactive in stopping the damage by sealing the hole and filling in the area under the porch to mitigate the damage that has been done and prevent further damage. As a reminder, maintenance and upkeep of front porches is the homeowner's responsibility, not the Homeowners Association.

Front Door Replacement must be approved by the ACC before work begins. Please follow the process noted above for approval. Front Doors should be painted the designated color listed in the KVTA paint schemes located on our Website. Wood-Stained doors are discouraged, as they require additional owner maintenance and are NOT cared for in the KVTA painting process.
